of King George the fourth, Intituled an Act to provide
for the Establishing of compositions for Tythes in Ireland
for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and
Just composition for all tythes arising, growing, yielded or
payable within the Parish of Killunaduma in the County
of Galway, do hereby Certify that the true and Just
Amount of composition for all Tythes whatever within
the Said Parish is one hundred Sixty six pounds ~~four~~ ^{thirteen}
~~pounds~~ by the year, of which Sum of One Hundred
and Fifty two Pounds fourteen Shillings & one Penny
are due and payable to the Rev Denis Brown as a
composition for the Tythe claimable by him as Rector of the Said
Parish and Fourteen ~~pounds~~ ^{pounds} is due and
payable to the Very Rev Dean Hawkins as Dean of Confort
And we do further Certify that the Average Price of wheat
being the Corn principally grown in Such County for the Period of
Seven years ending on the thirty first day of October 1821, one
is One Pound eight^(shillings) and eight Pence half penny per Barrel
Given under our Hands and seals this 17th day of September
1825 (Five)
