Compositions for Tithes in Ireland & to make such Compositions
permanant" do ascertain & fix a true & just Composition
for all Tithes, Arising, growing, yielded or payable
within the Parish of Hillcross in the County of Meath,
do hereby certify that the true & just Amount of Com-
position for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is
Two hundred & four Pounds by the year, of which sum of
Two hundred & four Pounds, One hundred & thirty six
Pounds are due & payable to Peter Metge Esquire as
Sole Proprietor of said Parish & Sixty eight Pounds
are due & payable to the Messrs William Henry Stone
as Vicar of said Parish.

And I do further certify that the average price of Oats
being the main principally grown in such County for the
Period of 7 years ending on the first day of November 1830
is Thirteen Shillings & three Pence three farthings of a Pound
