We John Allman of Eyrcourt and John Burke of Norman Grove in the County of Galway Esq^s Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth & intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time To ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Killeenavanna in the County of Galway do hereby Certify, that the true & Just amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is one Hundred and eighteen pounds ten Shillings Sterling by the year of which sum of one Hundred and eighteen pounds ten Shillings Sterling Fifty seven pounds fifteen Shillings Sterling is due and payable to George Dwyer as a Composition for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of said Parish and his Successors Thirty one pounds seventeen Shillings and Six pence Sterling are due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Clonfert & Kilmacduagh and his Successors and Twenty eight pounds seventeen Shillings and Six pence Sterling are due and payable to John Burke as Vicar of said Parish and his Successors — and we do further Certify, that the average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 one is ten Shillings and Six pence by the Acre

Whereas claim has been made by the Rector of Christ Church Dublin for a proportion of the tithes in the Townland of Killeenavanna in said Parish which claim has not been sufficiently proved to authorize us as Commissioners to include them in this Certificate
