hereby Certify that the true and Just Amount of Com-  
position for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish  
is Forty eight Pounds British Sterling by the year and  
which said Sum is due and payable to the Right Rev.  
The Lord Bishop of Limerick and his Successors Bishops  
of said Diocese for and during the Term of Twenty One  
years from the date hereof. And we do further Certify  
that the average Price of Wheat being the Com prin-  
cipally grown in such County for the period of Seven  
years ending on the first day of November 1791  
is three Pounds 10/- shillings & 0/2 pence per Barrel.  
Dated this twenty sixth day of April in the year One  
Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Six. -
