


We Hugh Frederick Finch and Edmond Moroney Esq^r

Certify that the true and Just Amount of Composition for
all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Forty eight pounds
British Sterling by the year which said Sum is due and
Payable to the Right Reverend The Lord Bishop of Limerick
and his Successors Bishops of said Diocess for and during
the Term of Twenty One years from the date hereof. — And
we do further Certify that the Average Price of Wheat being
the Corn principally grown in such County for the Period
of Seven years ending on the first day of November 1821
is One pound 10 Shillings & 0/2 Irish per Barrel. —
