act made in the fourth year of the reign of King
George the Fourth entitled an act to provide for
the establishing of a commission for Tithe in Ireland
for a limited time to ascertain & fix a true &
just composition for all Tithes arising growing
yielding & payable within the parish of Killham
in the County of Kerry do hereby certify that
the true & just amount of composition for
all Tithes whatsoever within said parish is
one Hundred & Thirty five Pounds by the year of which
sum of one Hundred & Thirty five Pounds two thirds part
are due & payable to Tho^s Slaughter Esq^r as
Lay Impropriator & one third part is due
& payable to the Rev^d Anth^y Slaughter as
Vicar of said parish

And we do further certify that the average
price of wheat being the corn (together with
Oats) principally grown in such county for
the period of seven years ending on the 29 Sept^r
last is 30 Shillings per Barrel of 20 Stone being at
the rate of 7:6 per Stone & that the average
price of Oats being corn also principally grown
such county for the said period of seven years
ending 29 Sept^r last is fifteen Shillings per Barrel
date the 21st August 1825 -
