 King George the fourth, providing for the Establishing of
 Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions
 permanent." to Ascertain and fix a true and Just
 Composition for All Tithes, arising, Growing, Yielded or
 payable, within the Parish of Killelan in the County of
 Kildare. Do hereby Certify that the true and Just Amount
 of Composition for All Tithes Whichever Within the said Parish of
 Killelan is Three Hundred and thirty pounds
 by the year of which Sum of Three Hundred and thirty pounds
 thirty there is due and payable to the Rev.^d
 Latham Coddington Vicar of said Parish the sum of One Hundred
and Ten pounds Præsent by the year for the
 Vicaral Tithes thereof And there is also due and payable to
 Sir Richard Steele Bart out of said sum of Three Hundred
and thirty pounds the sum of Two Hundred and
seventy pounds by the year for the lay impropriate or
 Redemal Tithes of said Parish and I do further Certify that the
 average price of Wheat being the corn principally grown
 in such County for the periods of seven years ending on the first
 day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty
 is One pound twelve Shillings and one half penny Præsent
 Given under My Hand this thirty first day of October
 One thousand Eight Hundred and thirty three.
