Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King  
George the fourth entitled "an Act to provide for the  
establishing of composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited  
time" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition  
for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable  
within the parish of Killena (the Townland of Sanduffe  
excepted) in the County of Wickford - Do hereby certify  
that the true and just amount of composition for all  
Tithes whatever within the said parish is one hundred  
and forty five pounds sterling (excepting as aforesaid)  
by the year which sum is due and payable to Mr John Pater  
as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as lessee to  
Hamilton Knox Graham Morgan Esqre the lay Impropriator  
thereof - Dated this 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1831 -
