Certificate of the Commissioners of the Parish of Killmoghk

We William Owen and Robert Fitzgerald commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of George the fourth entitled "an Act to provide for the establishing of a composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Killmoghk in the Queen's County do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is one Hundred and fifty two Pounds sixteen shillings and ten pence by the year. And We do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the Period of seven years ending the 1st day of November 1821 is £1.15.8 $\frac{1}{2}$ per barrel of 20 stone as appears by an Extract from the Dublin Gazette furnished us
