

I Frederick Hornum ^{appointed} Commissioner duly by the Lord Lieut
 & sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the 4th year of
 the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled an act to provide for
 the composition of Tithes in Ireland and also under the act of the 2^d
 and 3^d of William the 4th Cap. 119 to make such composition
 Permanent.

I do hereby certify that at a Vestry held at the William
 Burke's Hall in Dublin by public notice on the 3^d day of September
 1830 for the composition of Tithes in the Parish of Kilmoran Dioc
 of Elphin. A composition was agreed to for Seventy four pounds
 by the year for all Tithes whatever payable within said parish
 of Kilmoran alias Kilaoran to the Vicar which sum is ~~to be~~
 payable to the Rev^d. Dennis Kelly now Vicar of said Parish
 who has agreed to receive that sum annually for the vicarial
 Tithes of said parish. And I do further certify that the
 average price of oats (according to the Dublin Gazette) being
 the Corn principally grown in such Parish for the period of
 seven years ending on the 1st day of November 1830 is

Fiveteen Shillings & three pence three farthings per Barrel

The undersigned Parsonages of Kilmoran alias Kilaoran
 agree to pay the above sum of Seventy four pounds annually
 as the composition for the vicarial Tithes of said Parish
