

The Patents Carter and Thomas Jackson
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and
by virtue of an Act passed in the fourth year of the Reign
of George the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the
establishment of Compositions for tithes in Ireland
for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and
just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielding
or payable within the Parish of Killybeg in the County of
Sligo Do hereby certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all tithes whatever within the said
Parish is one Hundred and Five pounds a year of which
sum the two thirds being seventy pounds which with Fifteen
pounds for small dues or Family money being in the whole
Eighty five pounds are due, and payable to the Vicar M.
Boland as a Composition for the tithes and small
dues or Family money claimable by him as Vicar
of said Parish and one third of said one Hundred
and five pounds being Thirty five pounds are due and
payable to Isaac Barber of Sligo Esq as a Composition
for the tithes claimable by him as Lay Impropriator
of said Parish and we do further certify that
the average price of oats being the corn principally
grown in said County for the period of seven years
ending on the first day of November 1821 is Fifteen shillings
and two pence farthing per Bushel, Patt. Carter
Ballinacorney Septem ber 29th 1824. Thomas Jackson
