duly appointed and sworn under, and by Virtue of an Act
made in the ~~Second~~ and Third Year of *William the*
Fourth, entitled "An Act to amend Three Acts passed
respectively in the 4th, 5th, and 7th and 8th Years of the
Reign of his late Majesty, *King George the Fourth*, provi-
ding for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," to
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all
TITHES arising, growing, yielded or payable, within the
Parish of *Killesnoe Diocese of Tans and*
in the County of *Wexford* — do hereby certify that
the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatever within the said Parish, is *£ 312* Pounds
Seven Shillings and *four* Pence by the Year,
of which Sum of *£ 312* Pounds *Seven* Shillings
and *four* Pence are due and payable to the
following Persons, as a Composition for the Tithe
claimable by them: — *William* The Rev. *John*
Auchinleck Rector of Said Parish, being the average
for the Seven years preceding Nov^r 1830 —

And I do further certify that the Average Price of *Wheat*
being the Corn principally grown in such
County, for the Period of Seven Years, ending on the *first*
Day of *November* 1830 is *£ 1:12:0⁰*
~~Shillings~~ per Barrel.
