Twenty one pounds is due and payable to the very Reverend
the Dean and Chapter of Christ Church, Dublin - And
I do further certify that the average price of wheat, being
the Corn principally grown in such County for the period
of seven years ending on the first day of November in
the year One thousand Eight hundred and Thirty is
Thirty Two shillings and one halfpenny per Barrel -

Eight hundred and Thirty Three -
