duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue
of an Act made in the second and third years of
the Reign of King William the fourth intitled "An
Act to amend three Acts, passed respectively in
the fourth, fifth and seventh years of the Reign
of his late Majesty King George the fourth, pro-
-viding for the establishing of Compositions for tithes
in Ireland, and to make such Compositions, per-
-manent, to ascertain and fix a true and just Com-
-position for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or
payable within the Parish of Milliam, in the
County of Galway, do hereby certify that the
true and just composition for all tithes what-
-ever, within the said Parish, is one Hundred and
Seventy two Pounds Sterling by the year, of which
sum of one hundred and seventy two Pounds, one half
is due and payable to the Reverend Denis Kelly
the Vicar of the said Parish, for the tithes claim-
-able by him, and the other half is due and
payable to the Incorporated Society in Dublin
for promoting English Protestant Schools in
Ireland, as composition for all tithes claimable
by them. And I do further certify, that the
average price of wheat, being the Corn princi-
-pally grown in said County, for the period of seven
years ending on the first day of November 1830
is one pound twelve Shillings and one half penny
Sterling, in Pannel.
