of Hillsborough in the County of Down, Do hereby
certify that the true & just amount of composition
for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish
is One Hundred & Thirteen Pounds Twelve
Shillings & ten pence that by the year which
next is due & payable to the Rev. Fred. Blood
of Boston as Rector & Vicar of said Parish And
we do further certify that the average price of
wheat & oats being the four principal grains
in such Parish for the period of seven years
ending on the 31st Day of Nov^r 1821 are wheat
£1.10.0k - Oats £0.15.2k Signed
