fourth, intituled "An Act to amend three acts passed
respectively in the fourth, fifth and in the seventh and
eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George
the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Composition per-
manent; to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within
the Parish of Kellinagh in the County of Cavan. Do
hereby certify that the true and just amount of Compositions
for all Tithes whatsoever within said Parish is Two hundred
and Ninety Pounds by the Year, of which sum of Two
hundred and Ninety Pounds One Hundred and Sixty
Pounds are due & payable to Richard Saunders Esq.
Lay Proprietor, and the sum of One hundred and
thirty Pounds to the Rev^d Thomas Lanauze Vicar of said
Parish

And I do further certify that the Average price
of Cattle being the Corn principally grown in such County
for the period of seven years ending on the thirty first day
of December eighteen hundred and thirty, is twelve
Shillings & eleven pence halfpenny per Barrel
