

I Charles Puceval having been duly appointed and sworn Commissioner under and by virtue of an act made in the second and third year of the Reign of His Majesty King William the Fourth, Chapter one hundred and nineteen, entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively, in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eighth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland; and to make such Compositions permanent. / 16th August 1832. - To ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Billinane in the County of Carlow. Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and Seventy Pounds by the year payable to The Reverend James Wilson D. D. as Rector of the said Parish.

And
