in which an Act is provided for the Re-establishing of Compositions  
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix  
a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing  
yielded or payable within the Parish of Kildare in the  
County of Kerry do hereby certify that the true and just  
amount of Composition for all Tithes what ever within  
said Parish exclusive of the yearly produce of the Glebe,  
is Four Hundred and Forty nine pounds Sterling the year  
all which sum is payable to the Hon<sup>ble</sup> and Reverend  
Frederick Mullens as Rector and Vicar of said Parish  
and we do further certify that the average price of wheat  
being the corn principally grown in such County for the period  
of seven years ending on the thirty first day of October in  
the year of our Lord eighteen Hundred and Twenty one  
is thirty eight Shillings and eight pence half penny per Bush  
of Twenty Stone
