

Memorandum

The Parish of Killeenure alias Kullagh contains fourteen thousand two hundred and twenty two Acres one Rood and twenty nine perches of Land plantation Measure Eleven thousand seven hundred and eighty eight Acres two Roods and twenty eight perches of which are subject to pay the Lay-
~~Impropriator of said Parish the sum of four hundred and forty five pound Sterling p^{annum}~~ - The Land is divided into four Quarters for that purpose - Viz. the first Quality being of the Value of Thirty one Shilling & one p^{enny} to pay One Shilling and one farthing p^{acre} tithable - The second Quality being of the Value of Twenty four Shillings p^{acre} is to pay One penny halfpenny p^{acre} tithable the third Quality being of the Value of Twelve Shillings p^{acre} is to pay Six p^{enny} farthing p^{acre} tithable and the fourth Quality being of the Value of Eight Shillings p^{acre} is to pay 3 p^{enny} plus One tithable - and the Remainder of said fourteen thousand two hundred and twenty two Acres one Rood and twenty nine perches are Occupied as follows - Viz. Two thousand and sixty six Acres two Roods and fifteen perches are Baron's Lands Two hundred and eighty seven Acres two Roods and five perches are Glebe Lands Seventy nine Acres two Roods and nine perches are under publick Roads and Seven p^{enny} halfpenny plus is the p^{ercentage} on Thirteen thousand six hundred and ninety two pound, Seventeen Shillings and nine p^{enny} the Annual Value of said Parish -
