"Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth,
"and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late
"Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the Establishing
"of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions
"permanent" to Ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within
the parish of Killenker or Mullagh - - - in the county
of Cavan - - -

Do hereby Certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for the Tithes whatever within the said
parish is four hundred and forty five pounds Sterling by the year
which sum of four hundred and forty five pounds Sterling is due and
payable to the Reverend Edward Mahaffy as a composition for the
Tithes claimable by him as Lessee of George Walsh for the Lay
Impropriate or Rectorial Tithes of said Parish - - -

And I do further Certify that the average price of oats -
being the most principal grain in such Parish for the period of seven
years ending on the first day of November One thousand and Eight
hundred and thirty - - - is twelve shillings and seven pence
halfpenny per barrel - - - Given under my hand this
Twenty ninth day of October One thousand and Eight hundred and thirty
three - - -
