permanent" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the
Parish of Killenhurst or Mullagh in the County of Cavan —
Do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatever within the said parish is four hundred
and forty five pounds Sterl^l by the year which sum of four
hundred and forty five pounds Sterl^l is due and payable to the Revd.
Edward Mahaffey as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by
him as Lessee of George Welsh for the Lay Impropriate Rectorial
Tithes of said Parish — And I do further Certify that the
Average Price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such
County for the period of fifteen Years ending on the first day of
November One thousand eight hundred and thirty - is twelve
Shillings and Eleven pence Halfpenny per Barrell - Given under
my Hand this twenty ninth day of October One thousand eight
hundred and thirty three —
