

pursuant to the Statute by his Certificate fixed the amount of composition for Tithes in the said Parish of Kellenkerre or Mullagh at £445 sterling by the year which said sum of £445 was due and payable to the Reverend Edward Malraffy as Lessee of George Walsh the then Lay Impropriator of the Rectorial Tithes of said Parish And that the Rent Charge payable to the said Margaret Georgina Walsh and Sargent J. Evvard in lieu of said composition was £333.15.0 per annum being three fourths of the said sum of £445. And upon hearing the evidence given before the said Justice in open Court It is ordered by the said Justice that the said sum of £445 being the composition mentioned in said Certificate as payable to the Lay Impropriator be diminished by the sum of £60.2.0 and that the same shall be £384.18.0 annually and that pursuant to the Statute 14th Victoria cap 109 the Rent Charge in lieu of said reduced composition of £384.18.0 shall be three fourths thereof that is say a sum of £288.13.6 annually to be paid and payable to the parties entitled and that same shall commence and be payable from the first day of November 1896 And it is further ordered that the

assessment and apportionment of the said composition shall be amended accordingly and that the apportionment of the Rectorial Tithes Rent Charge in lieu of said composition so payable to the said Margaret Georgina Walsh and Sargent J. Evvard be reduced and diminished in like proportion.
