

I certify that I have received the following notice from Lord Crofton.

You are hereby required to take notice that in pursuance of an act passed in the 22<sup>d</sup> & 3<sup>d</sup> years of the reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth entitled an act to amend those acts passed respectively in the 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> and in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> years of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing compensation permanent for the portion of waste land which Lord Crofton seized in the counties of Wick, Donegal, Leitrim, and Cavan, the lands of Mebane, Lisnahoon, Tarnahoe, and Gaily the moor and houses whereof are as follows that is to say bounded on the North by Cullinogher and on the South by Cullinogher, and on the East by the Shannon and on the West by Cools Linn and Bredaunagh situated in the Parish of Kilmacsherry of the County of Wick, or being therein situated according to the provisions of said Act to give for and undertake the payment of the compensation for the lands hereby required for and in respect of the said lands such money as you may require for and to discharge the payment of such compensation as aforesaid for and in respect of the said lands and hereby require you to grant me a certificate in writing conformable to the provisions of the said Act declaring me entitled to the benefit of this notice and to perform the other matters on your part required by said Act to be done.
