Michl. Barclay Esq. who is Esq. of Binda Scott Esq.  
the Lay Proprietor of tithes in said parish.  
And as the aforesaid sum of the Hundred and  
thirty eight pounds two shillings and nine pence  
does not appear to be a just composition for the  
aforesaid M. Scott. I consider it just to add  
the further sum of Twenty one pounds, seventeen  
shillings and three pence by the year, on the  
following grounds - that the aforesaid J. B. become  
made considerable deductions in most cases, when  
settling with the parishons, and that some of those  
deductions arose from favours bestowed on said  
persons; these are my grounds and reasons, for  
adding to the average amount the sum of twenty  
one pounds, seventeen shill. and three pence by the  
year making in all the Hundred and sixty pounds  
by the year, due and payable to Binda Scott Esq.  
or his depue Michl. Barclay Esq. as Lay Proprietor  
and I do further certify that the average price of  
Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County  
and parish, for the period of seven years, ending the  
first day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1830 is twelve shill. & eleven pence  
half penny per Bushell Given under my hand
