

To all to whom these presents shall come I Matthew Clarke Esq of the Tithes of the Parish
of Temple Michael Killoe and Clonguish Killoe in the County of Longford and Greening
Whereas Willoughby Bond Esq of Tarraghoe in the County Longford has truly served
me with a notice in writing in words and figures following

Sir

you are hereby required to take notice that in pursuance of an Act passed in the
2nd and 3rd years of his Majesty King William the fourth entitled "An Act to amend
three Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of the reign of
his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland and to make such composition permanent. I Willoughby Bond Esq
Chief Landlord seized in Fee simple of all that and those the lands of Tarraghoe
Cullspad Muckna and Drumhoughly said townlands being in the Parish of Temple
Killoe Barony of Longford and County of Longford Also I the said Willoughby Bond
Chief Landlord seized in Fee simple of all that and those the lands of Ryan otherwise
Behine and the lands of Clonice said two townlands being in the Parish of Clonguish Killoe
Barony of Longford and County of Longford or being otherwise entitled according to the
provisions of the said Act and to agree for and undertake the payment of the Compositions
for Tithes lawfully payable for and in respect of the said lands do hereby signify to you
my desire to agree for and undertake the payment of such composition as aforesaid for and
in respect of the said lands. And I hereby require you to grant to me a certificate in
writing conformable to the provisions of the said Act declaring me entitled to the
