That in pursuance of an Act passed in the
2nd and 3rd years of his present Majesty, entitled, "An Act to amend
"three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th and in the 7th
"and 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the
"4th providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
"Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent;" -

And of an Act passed in the 3rd and 4th years of the same
reign entitled "An Act for the Relief of the Owners of Tithes in
Ireland and for the amendment of an Act passed in the
last Session of Parliament, entitled "An Act to amend three
Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th and in the 7th and 8th
years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the 4th
providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent;" -

I do hereby signify my desire and intention to agree
for and undertake the future payment of the Composition
and of all sums which shall become due and payable
on account of the Composition which under the laws in force
in Ireland is now fixed and Established as the Composition
for all Tithes for and in respect of the lands of Kiltgrace
Kilnatruan and Bundoom, situate in the Parish of Killeen
and County of Longford ————— which said lands

are bounded on the North by Boker, on the East by Corlea - Trelahan -
Clonce and Kiltrean on the South by Carriglogh and on the West by Kiltbegg and Drummoor -

And I hereby require you in pursuance of the Provisions of the
said Acts to grant me a Certificate under your hand and seal
reciting this Notice and declaring me entitled to the benefit thereof
Dated this 27th October 1874
