

We the Messrs John Dilmege and Joseph Ormsby Esqrs Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under
and by virtue of an Act intitled "An Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, ^(growing) yielded
or payable within the parish of Killogeelken in the County of Galway do hereby certify that the
true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever arising out of the Townland of
Farranamagh within the said parish is twenty pounds by the year: which sum of twenty
pounds is due and payable to John Fitzgibbon as Lessee to the Vicars Choral of Christs
Church Dublin, as a composition for the Tithes claimable by them as Rectorial Laymen
proprietors. And we do further certify that the average price of wheat being the corn pro-
duced in each county for the period of seven years ending on the first day of Novem-
ber one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is one pound eighteen shillings and
eight pence halfpenny per barrel as extracted from the Dublin Gazette. Dated
