appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made
in the Fourth year of the reign of King George the
Fourth entitled an Act, to provide for the establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for Vicarial Tithes arising growing Yielded, or payable
within the Parish of Skilshewick in the County of
Clare, do hereby Certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for Vicarial Tithes within the said
Parish is one Hundred, and fifteen Pounds Sterling
by the year, which sum is due and payable to the
Parson and the Westropp as a Composition for the Tithes
claimable by him as Vicar for said Parish.

And we further Certify that the average price of
wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County
for the period of seven years ending the first day
of November Eighteen Hundred and twenty one
is Seven Shillings and two pence farthing by the
Dublin Carriage Dated this 12th day of October 1824 From
