

Tithe composition certificate for the Townland of  
Killokenedy part of the parish of Killokenedy in the  
County of Clare and Diocese of Killaloe

I William Shack Commissioner duly appointed and  
sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the  
Reign of King George the 4<sup>th</sup> entitled an act to provide for the  
establishing of composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited  
time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all  
tithes, arising, growing, yielded, or payable in the townland  
of Killokenedy in the parish of Killokenedy and the Diocese of  
Killaloe in the County of Clare do hereby certify that the  
true and just amount of composition for all the prebendal tithes  
whatsomever within the said townland of Killokenedy is  
Seventy one pounds British ———— Sterling by  
the year the entire sum of which are due and payable to the  
Reverend Thomas, B. Brady as a composition for the tithes  
claimable by him as Prebendary of Killokenedy in said parish  
of Killokenedy

And I do further certify that the average price of  
oats being the corn principally grown in such County for the  
period of seven years ending the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1830  
is 12/11<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Pennell
