

At a Special Vestry of the Parishoners of
Killmahon in the County of Wick
Immediatly appointed on the 4th day called
the fourth day of October 1824 according to
the act of Parliament of the 4th of George the 4th
Chapter 99 and the 5th of George the 4th
Chapter 58. Providing for the establishing
for Compensation for Tithe in Ireland. That
Unanimously resolved and agreed to pay
into the Rev. John Duadell Rector and
Vicar of the St. Parish of Killmahon the
Sum of one hundred and thirty five pounds
per year for twenty one years from the first
day of November next ensuing without any
variation in the price of corn - and he hereby
appoints and nominates John ~~Lee~~ ~~Lee~~
as a fit and proper person to be a commis-
sioner on behalf of the owners and occupiers of
Land in the St. Parish of Killmahon for
carrying into execution the purposes of the
aforesaid act
