

At a special Vestry of the Parish of Killmahon, of
County Wick, and Diocese of
Down, duly appointed and duly called
the fourth day of October 1824 agreeable to
the act of Parliament of the 4th of George the 4th
Chapter 99 and the 5th of George the 4th
Chapter 68. In pursuance for the establishing
for Compensation for Tithes in Ireland. And
Unanimously resolved and agreed to pay
into the Rev. John Duadell Rector and
Vicar of the Parish of Killmahon the
Sum of one hundred and thirty five pounds
sterling for twenty one years from the first
day of November next ensuing. Without any
variation in the full amount. And he hereby
appoints and nominates John Green Esq.
as a fit and proper person to be a commissioner
on behalf of the owners and occupiers of
Land in the Parish of Killmahon for
carrying into execution the purpose of the
aforesaid act.
