fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising,
growing, yielded, or payable within the parish of Killowen
in the County of Clare do hereby certify that the true
and just amount of composition for all tithes whatever
within the said parish is one hundred and eighty pounds
by the year which sum is payable to Bindon Scott Esq^r
Lay impropriator as a composition for all tithes claim-
able by him

And we do further certify that the average price of
Oats being the Corn principally grown in such part of
the County for the period of seven years ending on the
1st day of December 1821 twenty one is ten Shillings per barrel of 48 lbs.
