

We John Allen of Tyrconnell and John Connolly of Corzoin in the County of Galway Esqrs Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under and by Virtue of an Act passed in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled "An Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Killora in the County of Galway and Diocese of Kilmacduagh, do here by certify that the true and just amount of Compositions for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is One Hundred and fifty seven Pounds Sterling by the Year, of which sum of One Hundred and fifty seven Pounds Sterling seventy nine Pounds Sterling are due and payable to the Rev^d Edward Martigan as a Composition for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of said Parish and his Successors, Fifty Pounds Sterling are due to Robert King as a Composition for tithes claimable by him as Archdeacon of said Parish and his Successors, Twenty eight Pounds Sterling are due and payable to the Bishop of Cloyne and his Successors and that the same shall continue for twenty one Years from the first day of Nov^r next without Alteration

We do further Certify that the average price of Oats being the Com^r principally grown in such Country for the period of seven Years, ending on the 1st day of Nov^r 1821, are is ten shillings and six pence by the Barrel.
