Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under
and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth
year of the reign of King George the Fourth,
intituled "An Act to provide for the establishment
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
time" to ascertain and fix a true and just com-
position for all tithes arising, growing, yielded
or payable within the Parish of Kibblinbeg in
the County of Cork, do hereby certify, that the
true and just amount of composition for all
Tithes whatever within the said Parish is sixty
pounds by the year; the whole of which sum
of sixty pounds is due and payable to the Bishop
of the Diocese of Cloyne as a composition for the
said Parish - And we do further certify, that the
said sum of sixty pounds by the year is to
remain and continue as the true and just a-
mount of composition for all tithes within said
Parish without variation for twenty one years
from the first day of November next ensuing
the date hereof. Whatever the price of corn may be
given under our hands this 24th day of
October 1824 twenty four
