

Original agreement - (copy) Aug 24 1826

It is hereby agreed on by the Rev. John Bury Palliser Rector of the parish of Kil St. Nicholas in the Diocese of Waterford and County of Waterford and by a special vestry duly held for said parish pursuant to the provision of the 4<sup>th</sup> George 4<sup>th</sup> Chap<sup>r</sup> 99 entitled an act for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time. That the sum of Two hundred and eight <sup>pounds</sup> twelve shillings and three pence British shall be paid as the annual composition under said act for all Tithes payable out of said parish to the aforesaid Rector John Bury Palliser for the full space of twenty one years without reference to the price of corn

Whereas the Rev. John Bury Palliser Incumbent of the Parish of Kil St. Nicholas in the Diocese of Waterford has agreed to receive the sum of Two hundred & eight pounds twelve shillings and three pence per annum as the amount of the composition to be paid for all Tithes in the said parish payable to him and has signified such agreement in writing stating the amount of the sum so agreed to and has obtained the assent of the Bishop of the said Diocese to said agreement and whereas his Majesty is patron of said Living We Richard Marquis Wellesley Lord Lieutenant General and General Governor of Ireland do hereby signify our assent to the said agreement - Given under our hand at his Majesty's

Castle of Dublin this 3<sup>d</sup> day of June 1826
