

Me John Swan & Charles A. O'Hara Esq^{rs} Commissioners duly
appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in
the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth, (entitled
an Act to provide for establishing of composition for Tithes
for a limited Period,) and amended by an Act made in the
fifth year of the Reign of the said King, Chap^r. 63. - to ascertain
and fix a true composition for all Tithes arising growing
yielded or payable within the Parish of Melloran, in the
County of Sligo - Do hereby certify that the true and just
amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within ^{the} said
Parish is three Hundred and thirty seven pounds by the year,
of which sum of three Hundred and thirty seven pounds,
the sum of one Hundred and twenty one pounds ten
Shillings is due and payable to the use of the Dean of
Down, as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him
as Rector of the said Parish; the said sum of one Hundred
and twenty one pounds ten Shillings, being a moiety of
the Tithes, accruing and payable by and out of the following
twenty one Town Lands. Viz. Cabragh, Cappagh, Canagh,
Carrowentavane being one quarter of Celona, Carrowgaveman,
Carowham and Trengrove part of do, Carrowlaghane,
Carrow McCarick & Carrowmullin, Carrowabragh,
Carrawacligh, Carrawaska, Crolang, Crevane,
Gurtakran, Knockatolane, Knockadoo, Rathbaron,
Rathosay, Roadstown or Ballinvalley, Swenys, & Shanough.
