Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under  
and by virtue of an Act, made in the second and  
third years of the reign of King William the  
fourth, intitled "an Act to amend three Acts passed  
respectively, in the fourth, fifth and seventh years  
of the reign of his late Majesty King George the  
fourth, Relating for the Establishing of Composition  
for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Com-  
position permanent," to ascertain and fix a true  
and just Composition for all Tithes arising,  
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of  
Killoseede in the County of Galway, do hereby  
Certify that the true and just amount of  
Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said  
Parish is Three Hundred and fifteen Pounds  
Sterling by the year, of which sum of Three hundred  
and fifteen pounds, one half is due and payable  
to the Vicar Choral of Christ Church and Saint  
Patrick, Dublin, as a Composition for the Tithes  
claimable by them, and the other half is due  
and payable to the Reverend Richard Marlow  
the Vicar of the said Parish.

And I do further certify that the  
average price of wheat, being the corn principally  
grown in said County, for the period of seven years  
ending on the first day of November 1830 - is One  
Pound twelve Shillings and one half penny per Barrel
