

I have given under Commission duly appointed by his  
Excellency the Lord Lieutenant and Council under and by virtue  
of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of George the fourth  
Chapter 99 entitled an Act to provide for the establishment of  
a composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time: And by  
virtue of an Act made in the second year of William the  
fourth Chapter 119 entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed  
respectively in the fourth fifth seventh and eighth years of the  
reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth: Proceeding  
for the establishment of a composition for tithes in Ireland and  
to make such composition permanent: To ascertain and fix  
a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing  
or payable within the Parish of Castlebliss in the  
Barony and County of Galway: do hereby certify that  
the true and just amt. of composition for all tithes whatever  
within the said Parish is Nine hundred and nine pounds  
four shillings and seven pence 4d by the year: of which  
sum three hundred and nine pounds four shillings and  
seven pence 4d shall be paid by the year and  
be due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Chas<sup>r</sup> W. Dool as Rector of said  
Parish, and that the sum of nine pounds four shillings and  
seven pence 4d shall be due and payable to Lord  
Clontarf Treasurer of the Rectorial Tithes of certain
