of the Parish of Castleblakeney,  
The Rev. Daniel Lucas  
Rector & Vicar

Signed Oct<sup>r</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> 1825

We John O'Rourke & Patrick Joyce - Commissioners duly appointed  
- sworn - under & by virtue of an Act made in the fourth  
year of the reign of King George the Fourth - entitled "an Act to  
provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland  
for a limited time" to ascertain & fix a true & just Composition  
for all Tithes arising - growing - yielding - or payable in the  
Parish of Mellisolan - otherwise Castleblakeney - in the County  
of Galway - to the Rev. Daniel Lucas - Rector & Vicar of said  
Parish - Do hereby Certify - that the true & just amount for  
all such Tithes - within said Parish is Three Hundred and  
Twenty five pounds Sterling by the year - the whole of which sum  
is due & payable to the said Rev. Daniel Lucas as a Composition  
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector & Vicar of the said  
Parish for the term of Twenty one years - from the date hereof

And we do further certify that the average price  
of Oats - being the Corn principally grown in such County  
for the period of seven years - ending the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Novem-  
ber 1825 is fourteen Shillings a Barrel - Given under  
our hands this 17<sup>th</sup> of October 1825
