I Daniel John Quinn Commissioner duly appointed by his  
Excellency the Lord Lieutenant and sworn under and by virtue  
of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of George the fourth  
Chapt. 99 entitled an Act to provide for the Establishment of  
Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, and by  
virtue of an Act made in the second and third of William the  
Fourth Chapt. 119 Entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed  
respectively in the fourth fifth seventh and eighth years of the  
reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth, Providing  
for the establishment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland and  
to make such Composition permanent, To ascertain and fix  
a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing  
yielding or payable within the Parish of Castleblaney alias  
Killoolan and County of Galway, do hereby certify that  
the true and just amt. of Composition for all Tithes whatever,  
within the said Parish is three hundred and nine pounds  
four shillings and seven pence 4d. by the year, of which  
sum of three hundred and nine pounds four shillings and  
seven pence 4d. three hundred pounds by the year are  
due and payable to the Rev. Chas. M. Doyle as Rector of said  
Parish, and that the sum of nine pounds four shillings and  
seven pence 4d. by the year is due and payable to Lord  
Clonbrock as owner of the Rectorial Tithes of certain
