 duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an
 Act made in the fourth year of the reign of George the
 fourth entitled an Act to provide for the Establishing
 of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland for a limited
 time to ascertain and fix a true and just Compen-
 sation for all Tythes arising growing yielding or
 Payable within the parish of Kilmucklin in the County
 of Down do hereby Certify that the true and
 just Amount of Composition for all Tythes
 whatsoever within the said parish is one hundred and
 forty nine pounds nine Shillings by the year of
 which sum of one hundred and forty nine pounds
 nine Shillings the sum of seventy eight pounds
 eight Shillings is due and payable to Edward Bule
 Esq as Lay impropriator and the sum of seventy
 one pounds one Shilling is due and payable to
 the Reverend John Cary the Vicar of said Parish
 Such Composition to commence and take effect
 from the first day of November last according to an
 Agreement entered into at the original Vestry held
 on the twenty second day of October 1827 and
 to continue in full force for twenty one years
 and we do further Certify that the average price
 of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such
 County for period of seven years ending on the
 first day of November 1821 is ten Shillings and
 six pence per Barrel given under our hands
 this first day of April 1828 Eight
