"for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and
just composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or
payable within the Parish of Kilowlah in the County of
Westmeath, do hereby certify that the true & just amount
of composition for all tithes whatever within the said
Parish, is one hundred and fifty two pounds six shillings
and one penny three farthings British Currency, of which
sum of one hundred and fifty two pounds six shillings
and one penny three farthings, Thirly six pounds eighteen
shillings & nine pence halfpenny is due and payable
to the Rev^d Michael Decourcy Doctor in Divinity as
a composition for the tithe claimable by him as Vicar
of the said Parish; and that the remainder of said
sum of one hundred and fifty two pounds six shillings
and one penny three farthings British Currency, being
one hundred and fifteen pounds seven shillings and
eight pence one farthing is due and payable to Nicholas
Ogle Esq^r as a composition for the tithes claimable by him as impropriator
