of Composition for all Rectorial Tythes whatever within the Said Parish is
forty two Pounds by the year which Sum of forty two Pounds is due and
payable to Lord Viscount Sinton as a Composition for the Tythe Claimable
by him as Rector of the Said Parish of Killummod.

And We do further Certify that the Average price of Oats being
the Com^monably grown in Such County for the period of Seven years
ending 1st November 1821 is fifteen Shillings and two pence halfpenny
per Barrel — Dated this 15th day of April in the Year of our
Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty eight.
