We Edward O'Callaghan and William Welsh Commissioners
 duly appointed and sworn, under and by Virtue of an act
 made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth
 Entitled "An act to provide for the establishing of composition
 for tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain
 and fix, a true and just composition for all tithes
 arising growing yielded or payable in the Parish
 of Killurane in the County of Clare, do hereby certify
 that the true and just amount of all tithes whatsoever
 within the said Parish is Two hundred and four pounds
 one Shilling and eight pence (British) by the year, of which
 sum Seventy eight pounds five shillings and six pence
 halfpenny (British) is due and payable to the Rev Francis
 Synge, as a composition for all tithes claimable by him
 as Rector of said Parish, That the sum of Ninety two
 pounds six shillings and three halfpence (British)
 is due and payable to the Rev W^m Butler, as a compo-
 sition for the tithes claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish
 And that the sum of thirty three pounds ten shillings
 (British) by the year is due and payable to the Rev W^m Butler
 as a composition for the tithes claimable by him as
 Rector and Prebend of Tomgreney - And we do further
 certify that the average price of oats, being the
 corn principally grown in said Parish, for the term
 of seven years, ending the 21st day of November 1826
 was fourteen shillings and one farthing (British)
 per barrull as taken from the Dublin Gazette
