

I John Penderast Commissioner duly appointed and sworn,
under and by virtue of an act made in the second and third years of
the reign of his present majesty King William the fourth, intituled
an act to amend three acts passed respectively, in the fourth, fifth,
and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late ma-
jesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of com-
position for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such composition
paramount, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition, for all Tithes,
arising, growing, gaillard, or payable within the Parish of Killury, in
the County of Kerry, do hereby certify, that the true and just
amount of composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish of Killury, is Three hundred and Ninety-two Pounds Six
Shillings and two pence Sterling British currency by the year, which
sum of Three hundred and Ninety-two Pounds Six Shillings and two
pence Sterling, is due and payable to the Reverend Richard
Plummer, as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as
Rector and Vicar of Said Parish.

And I do further certify that the average price of Wheat being
the Corn principally grown in Said County for the period of seven
years ending the first day of November one thousand eight hundred
and Thirty, is One Pound twelve Shillings and a half penny per barrel
dated this 27th day of September 1834 year-
