Tithe Composition

I Silvester Rait having been duly appointed & sworn Commissioner under & by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, & by virtue of an Act passed in the second & third years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the fourth intituled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, & in the seventh & eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland & to make such Compositions permanent & to ascertain & fix a true & just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable, within the Parish of Killybegs in the County of Kildare, do hereby Certify that the true & just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is One hundred & thirteen pounds ten shillings & three pence half penny Stg. by the year, the whole of said Sum is due & payable to the Reverend William Parsons Incumbent as a Composition for the Tithe Claimable by him as Owner of the Rectorial & Vicarial Tithes in said Parish

And I do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending the
