*Charles Percival*, having been duly appointed and sworn commissioner, under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third year of the Reign of His Majesty King William the Fourth Chapter 119 - intitled, an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishment of Compositions of Tithes in Ireland. And to make such composition permanent. - 16<sup>th</sup> August 1832. - To ascertain a true and just composition for all such Tithes, arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Blinacahil, in the County of Kilkenny - Do hereby certify, that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever, within the said Parish, is Three hundred and seventy pounds by the year, of which sum of Three hundred and seventy pounds, one hundred and seventy pounds, is due and payable to the Reverend James Morgan Stables, as composition for the Tithes claimed by him, as Vicar of said Parish of Blinacahil, Diocese of Leighlin. - The sum of One hundred pounds by the year, is due and
