Kilmocur in the County Kilkenny do hereby Certify that
the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Two Hundred and fifty Eighth
pounds by the year of which ^{Sum} of Two Hundred and fifty
Eighth pounds the Sum of One Hundred and seventy ^(two)
pounds is due and payable to David Burtchall Esqr as
Lessee to the Marquess of Ormonde as a Composition for all
the Improper Tithes of the said Parish

And the Sum of Eighty six pounds of said Two Hundred and
and fifty Eighth pounds is due and payable to the Rev^d
Francis Lodge as a composition for the Vicarial Tithes as Vicar
whereof

And I do further Certify that the Average Price of
Wheat being the Corn principally ^{grown} in such County for the
period of seven years ending on the first day of November
Eighteen Hundred and Thirty is Thirty two shillings and one
half penny per Barrel
