the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions  
for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent  
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes  
arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Kilmocar  
in the County Kilkenny do hereby certify that the true and  
just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said  
Parish is Two Hundred and fifty Eighth pounds by the year of  
of which Sum of Two Hundred and fifty Eighth pounds the  
Sum of One Hundred and Seventy pounds is due and payable  
to David Pardehall Esqr. as Lessee to the Marquess of Ormonde  
as a Composition for the Improperiate Tithes of the said Parish  
And the Sum of Eighty six pounds of said Two Hundred  
and fifty Eighth pounds is due and payable to the  
Rev<sup>d</sup>. Francis Lodge as a composition for the Vicarial Tithes  
as Vicar thereof

And I do further certify that the average price  
of Wheat being the corn principally grown in such County  
for the period of seven years ending on the first day of  
November Eighteen Hundred and thirty is thirty two shillings  
and one half penny per Barrel
