

Certificate of Composition, Parish of Kilmacdonough

I Walter Lindsay Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in 2^d and 3^d years of the Reign of his present Majesty King William the 4th entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 11th 13th & 14th years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent to as certain & fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilmacdonough in the County of Cork do hereby Certify that the true & just amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is One Pound and two Shillings per annum of which sum of one Pound and two Shillings per annum one third part is due and payable to The Rev. Thomas Dinn as a Composition for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of said Parish, or as Procurator of the Rector of Kilmacdonough, and one third part is due and payable to The Rev. John Leslie the Vicar of said parish.

And I do further Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven years ending the 1st day of November 1830 is One pound twelve shillings & one half penny per Barrel.
